This policy covers **Northern Polymers and Plastics Ltd** and **Envinylmental Waste and Commodity Ltd**, which is part of the **Northern Polymers and Plastics Group**.

Northern Polymers and Plastics Ltd [NPP] is a polymer company engaged within many areas of the plastics and polymers industry. We are suppliers of a comprehensive range of Prime, Hybrid and **Recycled Polymer** materials, including but not exclusively, **PolyVinyl Chloride (PVC)**, PolyPropylene (PP), PolyEthylene (PE), Acrylonitrile Butadiene Styrene (ABS), PolyStyrene (PS) sourced from our trusted worldwide network of polymer manufacturers. As a company we have a specialisation in PolyVinyl Chloride (PVC).

As a company primarily engaged with the buying and reselling of plastic raw materials, we operate a very low environmental impact business, and our rejected items are significantly minimised. We have a positive impact on the environment using exclusive partner companies who wholly recycle all our rejected items, and we are committed to prevent waste and pollution in every aspect of our activities.

Envinylmental Waste and Commodity (Envinylmental) is dedicated to creating a sustainable future through comprehensive recycling services. Our mission is to reduce waste, conserve natural resources, and promote environmental stewardship. We specialise in the recycling of paper, cardboard, plastic, PVC and metal, ensuring that these materials are processed responsibly and efficiently.

NPP and Envinylmental are committed to sustainable development [meeting the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs], as a guiding principle within our business. Concern for the environment is an integral and fundamental part of this commitment. Our aim is to reduce any impact on the environment arising from our business operations.

- Closely monitor its Scope 1 and 2 emissions [www.carbontrust.com/our-work-and-impact/guides-reports-and-tools/sme-carbon-footprint-calculator].
- Obtain Scope 1 and 2 emissions information from suppliers and provide the same to its customers when requested to.
- Monitor and reduce the use of energy, water and other resources, measuring environmental impact.
- Minimise waste by reduction, re-use and recycling methods.
- Comply with all relevant environmental legislation/regulation.
- Identify and provide appropriate training, advice and information for staff [e.g. use of Spill Kit in case of spillage of plasticiser oil – *‘Material/Liquid Spills’ document refers*].
- Provide appropriate resources to meet the commitments of this policy.

Involve and Communicate.

NPP and Envinylmental will document and communicate this policy to all employees and encourage them to participate.

Review.

This policy will be reviewed annually at Management Review.

The impacts of existing environmental and sustainability actions are reviewed.

Changes are made based on the results of the review and based on any other changes to NPP and Envinylmental’s policy and/or legislative changes.
